Auxin Applicator Training

The mandatory auxin-specific training for all applicators is a new change that applies to not only those with applicators license, but also to those making applications under someone else's license. This requires awareness for all applicators to ensure their ability to use these herbicides in 2018 and in subsequent years.

New restrictions include a provision requiring annual mandatory auxin-specific training for every person that will be applying Dicamba containing products to any row crop.
