Seed Cotton Program Webinar

As you have probably seen in news, the budget agreement passed last week and signed by President Trump included the Hurricane Disaster Supplemental. Included in the Disaster Supplemental is language that establishes a Seed Cotton program for 2018. The effort to get cotton back in Title 1 of the farm bill is an issue that the cotton industry, led by the National Cotton Council with support from South Texas Cotton & Grain Association, has worked on for the past three years.

The National Cotton Council is hosting a series of information webinars regarding provisions of the recently authorized 2018 Seed Cotton farm program. Information will be provided on provisions of the Seed Cotton program including examples of support levels under various price scenarios and examples of generic base conversion options. In addition, updates on the new farm bill will be discussed. Participants will have an opportunity to ask questions at the end of each session.
